
The Whitehorse Photography Club Presents...

SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 25 8:30AM TO 4:30PM FIELD WORK AND PHOTO EVALUATION

We will be trying something very different for the all-day workshop. Originally limited to 10 people, we've asked André to consider a new approach that would allow up to 30 people to collaborate on up to 10 teams.

The session begins with 90 minute teaching program and an in-depth look at techniques and using Photoshop and then a 2.5-hour shooting session until lunch. After lunch, each team member selects two of their images followed by an evaluation for participants to get feedback on their images.

The day ends with a short program on motivation.
